Sir,

I have to bring to your notice that on 1/5/28 at Chahafi 8 pigs belonging to one Porisi of your territory destroyed 3 shambas (2 of mutama and 1 of beans) whereupon they were seized and put in to the quarantine camp pending further instructions from the County Chief.

2. It is said that your people seeing what had been done crossed the frontier and without preferring their complaint to the chief forcibly seized 12 head of cattle and took them off.

3. I should be glad if you would kindly take steps to have the cattle returned, compensation paid to the owners of the damaged shambas, and some punishment inflicted on the culprit.

4. I wish to point out that this is not the first time your natives have crossed in to our border and forcibly taken the law in to their own hands. I trust you will be able to see your way to inflict a deterrent sentence on conviction and to prevent further repetitions of this lawlessness.

5. The witnesses have been ordered to report to you.
